Pioneers

Entering Grades K & 1: Weeks 1-9

Campers experience new adventures through discovery and play. Activities include water games, outdoor play, arts and crafts, group games, literacy, and dramatic arts. Each week features a new theme.

Explorers

Entering Grades 2 & 3: Weeks 1-9

This traditional outdoor camp group provides campers the opportunity to explore and develop their own interests through a variety of camp activities such as art, active play, and swimming. Campers will gain independence, as well as learn responsibility and how to work together as a group through team-building activities.

Discovery

Entering Grades 4 & 5: Weeks 1-9

This traditional outdoor day camp provides campers will explore a variety of traditional camp activities such as arts & crafts, swimming, games, and team-building. They'll develop social skills, independence, learn how to work as a team and make new friends.

Musical Theater

Entering Grades K-5: Weeks 4-8

From scene work and ensemble acting skills in this camp designed for all future actors and actresses. Campers learn scripts and character development as they rehearse, create, and prepare for their big performance in front of friends and family.

Dance

Entering Grades K-5: Weeks 1, 5 & 7

Dancers will learn to tumble, explore different styles of dance and work on routines to perform for the camp at the end of the week. Dancers will play dance related games, learn choreography and even make their own costumes for the end of week performance! No experience is required! Campers will then join the traditional camps.

Aqua

Entering Grades 2-5: Weeks 1 & 9

Get ready to splash into the terrific week of water sports, safety around water, swim lessons and lifeguard for a day! Participants must be able to pass a yellow band swim test (swim half a length of the pool on front and float for 30 seconds unassisted).
